I can edit it and add a little now and then. It is one way you can advertise your own show. It goes to

everyone on our emailing list, about 140.

I love doing the **Tickler** (ie: Tickling your memory for First Friday stops!) for our members and even other folks. Usually I only send it out once, so remembering after you get your tickler is too late! Just send a couple sentences the Monday before First Friday of your show, when you send in the Latitudes notice to the News-Miner. I send the tickler out on Wednesdayafternoon or evening... Thanks, nn
